

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (2324.09) BETWEEN  
PETALUMA CITY (ELEMENTARY) AND JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICTS  
AND  
PETALUMA FEDERATION OF TEACHERS**


The Petaluma City Schools District ("District") and The Petaluma Federation of Teachers ("PFT") agree to the following one-year Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") related to **Phone Stipends for School Psychologists** effective February 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024.

District psychologists may be assigned to multiple school sites and are expected to respond to emergencies and important requests from schools and staff across the District. As a result, mobile phones are required to facilitate communication between District psychologists and other District staff during the workday.


Beginning February 1, 2024, District psychologists will receive a monthly phone stipend of \$50. This stipend may be used to purchase a work-specific mobile phone or applied to the cost of a personal mobile phone. Beginning February 1, 2024, District psychologists will provide supervisors with the mobile number by which they can be reached during the work day.

This MOU is non-precedent setting and shall sunset June 30, 2024 unless the parties mutually agree to extend in writing.




