Upon verification of a quorum:

- 1. Approve October 8, 2015 meeting minutes
- 2. Re-appointment of Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary. According to the Committee Bylaws Section 9. Officers: 'these positions shall serve in such capacities for a term of one year and may be re-elected by vote of a majority of the members of the Committee'.
- 3. Re-appointment of Members. Due to Committee Bylaws Section 5. Membership 5.6 Removal; Vacancy 'failure to attend two consecutive Committee meetings without reasonable excuse': Dan Drummond is no longer qualified to be a member of the Committee. Alice Christiansen is currently a member of the organization and also belongs to the Tax Payer's Organization. It is recommended that she be re-appointed to be the Tax Payer's Organization representative.  - (a) Receive and review copies of the District's annual independent performance audit and annual independent financial audit, required by Article XIIIA of the California Constitution, which audits must be performed in accordance with Government Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the U.S. and must be submitted to the Committee at the same time that they are submitted to the Board of Education for approval, and in any event no later than March 31 of each year.
- 5. Annual Report to the Board of Education on January 26, 2016. According to Committee Bylaws Section 3.3 Annual Report: The Committee shall present to the Board, in public session, an annual written report which shall include the following:
 - (a) A statement indicating whether the District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIIIA, Section 1 (b)(3) of the California Constitution with respect to both Measure E and Measure C; and
 - (b) A summary of the Committee's proceedings activities for the preceding year.
