A-G Freshman Admission Requirements

- A. History/Social Sciences 2 years
- B. English 4 years
- C. Math 3 years (4 recommended, Math 3 or higher)
- D. Lab Science 2 years required (3 recommended)
- E. Language Other than English 2 years (3 recommended)
- F. Visual & Performing Art 1 year
- G. College Prep Elective 1 year
 - Testing (ACT/SAT) test optional (11th/12th)
 - → Minimum GPA 2.5 for CSU schools
 - → Minimum 3.0 GPA for UC schools
 - → Grades must be "Cs" and higher
 - → NO Ds OR Fs!!

Applying to CSU (California State University) Schools

- Application opens October 1st, apply between October 1st November 30th
- 23 campuses, 1 application, \$70/school
- Must meet the A-G subject areas requirements
- GPA (2.5 minimum in A-G coursework), no Ds/Fs
- No Test scores required (optional)
- No letters of recommendation
- No Early Action/Early Decision



Admit Using CSU Eligibility vs. Impacted Campuses

Can get in with A-G requirements:

Honors Programs at CSU Schools

- 14 of the 23 campuses offer Honors Programs
- Programs vary across campuses but overall will provide extra support, smaller class sizes, more opportunities to internships, etc.
- Entrance requirements vary by campus but usually students must meet a GPA or ACT/SAT test score minimum to apply
- Some CSU schools even offer more financial aid (ex: Fresno State -4 years 100% free tuition)
- Visit corresponding school website for more info
- Might have a separate application/deadline

Applying to UC (University of California) Schools

- Application is open, submit between October 1st November 30th
- 9 campuses, one application, \$80/school
- Must meet the A-G subject areas requirements
- GPA (3.0 minimum in A-G coursework), no Ds/Fs
- No Test scores required (optional)
- PIQs (must answer 4 of 8) NOT AN ESSAY
- No letters of recommendation
- No Early Action/Early Decision



Private Schools, Out of State, NCAA

Common Application

- Typically need 1 letter of recommendation from a teacher and 1 from a counselor
- Must invite your recommenders!
- Supplemental Essays as well

Other private and out of state colleges

Each school will have different deadlines and accounts

NCAA

- Must be registered with eligibility center, registrar will upload your transcript here
- Know the requirements
- Work directly with coaches

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

- A coalition of schools
 throughout the west that offer
 discounted tuition to students
 that meet certain criteria (GPA &
 Test Scores)
- Often times tuition can be even more affordable than in state colleges
- Usually 3.0+ GPA required



SAT/ACT

Currently, only 4 percent of colleges that use the Common Application system require a standardized test such as the SAT or the ACT for admission.

Out of State - FL, GA,

U.S. Military Academy (Army), West Point, New York

U.S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland

U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado

Tips For College Applications

- ✓ Look at majors for your colleges (if applicable) before you start your application
- ✓ Save two copies of all usernames and passwords
- ✓ Use your personal email address (petk12 email expires after graduation)
- ✓ Try to submit all applications before Thanksgiving break
- ✓ Have someone review your application and essays
- ✓ Attend campus tours



Letters of Recommendation

- CSU and UC schools do NOT accept letters of rec
- Please give your counselor & teachers three weeks notice all packets are due by Friday, November 17th
 - Early Decision/Action due September 29th
- Letter of rec packets are available online and on the counseling website
- Invite your recommenders online!
- Check your school for specific deadlines
- Remember to THANK your recommenders!

I've Applied, Now What?

Check to do list & emails through individual student portals before AND after accepted

May 1 – Statement of Intent to Register

- ◆ Provide deposit one school ONLY
- Housing may need to apply early

Wait List - need to register at accepted school even though on a waitlist

Transcripts & Test Scores

- CSU/UC Schools due AFTER graduation by July 1, 2024!
- Occasionally, mid year transcripts are requested, students would be notified through their college student portal.
- Request via Parchment
- Common Applications, Coalition & SENDEDU will be uploaded electronically by your counselor.
- <u>SAT</u>, <u>ACT</u>, and <u>AP</u> scores students must send themselves, not done by PHS.
 - Save money by inputting your schools at the time of testing!

- **December:** FAFSA/CA Dream Act Applications open
- **TBD:** Financial Aid/Cash for College Night
- **December 1st:** PHS Scholarships & PEF Scholarships open
- **December 1st**: 10,000 Degrees scholarships open
- **January 25th:** PEF Scholarships deadline
- January 31st: PHS Scholarships deadline
- **April 2nd**: FAFSA and CA Dream Act Deadline
- **April 17th (CGHS)**: PEF Scholarship Reception
- **April 25th**: Community Achievement Awards (Top 10)
- **May/June:** Senior Recognition Awards

Final Thoughts

- Senior year does count
 - ☐ Stay on track (Cs and higher!)
 - ☐ Admission can be rescinded
- Maintain communication- check PHS email, listen to announcements, check college portals
- Change in schedule (dropping or adding classes) -must notify colleges ASAP
- ☐ Talk to your counselor or the CCC for extra support
