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Four Year College (A-G Requirements)

A. History/Social Sciences - 2 years required

B. English - 4 years required

C. Math - 3 years (4 recommended, Math 3 or higher)

D. Lab Science (2 years required, 3+ years recommended)

E. Language Other than English - 2 years required (3 years recommended)

F. Visual & Performing Art - 1 year required

G. College Prep Elective - 1 year required

Testing - ACT or SAT, minimum GPA 2.0 for CSU schools and minimum 3.0 GPA for UC schools. Grades must be "Cs" and higher (**Ds & Fs do not count**)

Graduation Requirements

Social Sciences - 30 credits (3 years required)

English - 40 credits (4 years required)

Math - 20 credits (2 years required, 1 year must be from Math 1)

Science - 20 credits (2 years)
1 year of Physical, 1 year of Biological

Foreign Language or Visual Performing Art - 10 credits in either area (1 year)

Physical Education - 20 credits (2 years required)

Electives - 65 credits (6.5 classes)
Human Interaction - 5 credits (1 semester)
